FIELD

The field will be limited to 144 participants. All entries subject to tournament committee approval.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

1. All entries must be filed on the Official Entry Application (Attached). Incomplete entry applications and telephone entries are not accepted.
2. All entries must be mailed to Maumelle Charity Classic, 100 Club Manor Drive, Maumelle, AR 72113, and must be received by 5:00 p.m., Monday, April 25th, 2005.
3. The entry fee of \$175.00, cart included for tournament only, made payable to Maumelle Charity Classic, must accompany the entry application.
4. Entrants will be notified if field is full.
5. Withdraw: If an entrant withdraws before April 25th, 2005, entry fee will be refunded. No refunds will be made after April 25th, 2005. All dates refer to dates received by Maumelle Country Club, not postmark date.
6. For questions on entries, phone the Pro Shop (501) 851-3700 (between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday).
7. Alternative (non-metal) spikes are required.

SCHEDULE (3 DIVISIONS)

Open Division: Play will be 54 holes stroke play.

Mid-Senior & Senior Division: Play will be 54 holes stroke play. Verification of age must accompany entry form.

AWARDS

Championship: Jacket, gift certificate to champion and name on permanent trophy.

Places: Approximately 30% of each field will be awarded gift certificates. Total prizes based on number of participants per division.

President's State Team Championship: A plaque will be awarded to the (3) low finishers from the state with the lowest total score after 54 holes. Their names and state will go on the permanent President's Trophy. (open division only)

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TIES

In case of a tie for the championship (all divisions), “a sudden death” playoff to determine the winner will be held immediately upon conclusion of the tournament. Such playoff will start on hole #10. All other ties will be split equally.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE WILL BE IN CHARGE OF PLAY

Play will be governed by the 2004-2005 Rules of the United States Golf Association and by the Local Rules and Definitions established by the Rules Committee. The “one-ball” rule will be in effect. The Rules Committee, whose decision will be final, will settle all special questions. Special rules of play bulletins will be furnished each day at the starter tent if conditions warrant.

REGISTRATION

Immediately upon arrival at Maumelle Country Club, report to the registration desk to pick up your contestant envelope. The registration desk will be located downstairs next to the men’s locker room.

DRESS CODE

On the Golf Course: No cut-offs, no bathing suits, and no tank tops. Shirts must have collars. Spikeless golf shoes are mandatory. The dress code applies during practice rounds and all tournament play.

PRACTICE PRIVILEGES

Course will be open Thursday, April 28th, 2005, for practice. The #1 tee will be closed at 3:00 p.m. for the Shootout. Call Pro Shop for tee times (501-851-3700).

PAIRINGS

Pairings and start times for 1st round will be posted at the Pro Shop and Men’s Locker Room on Thursday, April 28th, 2005. Pairings and start times for Saturday and Sunday’s tournament play will be posted in the Pro Shop and Men’s Locker Room.

CLUB STORAGE AND PRACTICE BALLS

Club storage facilities are available. Contact the Pro Shop for details. The Maumelle Country Club driving range will be used for pre-round warm-up only. All other range practice will be conducted at the Maumelle Driving Range at the participant’s expense. See below for details.

DIRECTIONS TO COURSE

Maumelle Country Club is located approximately five (5) miles from Little Rock. From Interstate 430 take Exit 12, West, approximately 3.5 miles on Maumelle Blvd. Take Arnold Palmer drive West, to Club Manor Drive then West directly to the Club.

DIRECTIONS TO MAUMELLE DRIVING RANGE

From Maumelle Country Club, take Club Manor Drive to Arnold Palmer Drive, turn right. Take Arnold Palmer Drive to Maumelle Blvd., turn right. Take Maumelle Blvd. to Counts Massie Rd., turn left (at the McDonalds). Driving range is 1/4 mile down the road on the right hand side of the road.

Dear Potential Participant:

A brief note to encourage you to participate in the 2005 Twin City Bank Maumelle Charity Classic. The Classic is held at Maumelle Country Club, Maumelle, Arkansas, only 10 minutes from West Little Rock. Maumelle Country Club is rated one of the top courses in the state of Arkansas. The Arkansas State Golf Association frequently utilizes Maumelle Country Club as a state tournament site, and the course is a challenging test. Years past, it has been host to satellite PGA events in 1987 and in 1988 was a TPA stop.

The Tournament Committee promised that 2004 would be an exciting event and the players provided exactly that despite a rain shortened event. University of Memphis senior, Allan Thomas, fired a 2-under par final round to catch three-time champion, Danny Green. Thomas won the second hole of the sudden death playoff to capture his first Maumelle Classic title. Thomas continued his great play by capturing the ASGA Stroke Play Championship later that summer. He stated that winning the Maumelle Classic had been a career goal.

It is the intention of the Tournament Committee for the Classic to continue to expand as a premier Amateur Tournament in the South. With this thought in mind, we have invited top amateurs of the states contiguous to Arkansas. Along with you, we have mailed invitations to these high quality competitors to assemble the strongest field. The combination of a championship golf course with championship caliber players will lead to another great tournament this year.
