ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to all amateur golfers, with the following restrictions: *Mid-Senior Flight* golfers shall have reached their 40th birthday by July 4, 2008; *Senior Flight* golfers shall have reached their 55th birthday by July 4, 2008 and *Super-Senior Flight* golfers shall have reached their 65th birthday by July 4, 2008.

FORMAT

Five flight classifications: *Championship, Mid-Senior, Senior, Super-Senior* and *Match-Play*. Entrants shall designate the flight in which they desire to compete and may compete in only one flight. Only entrants in championship flight are eligible to win the championship.

Championship Flight (ASGA Designated): 54 holes stroke play to be played as follows: *Friday, July 4:* 18 holes; *Saturday, July 5:* 18 holes. The top 50% of the field shall continue play *Sunday, July 6:* 18 holes (remainder eliminated after 36 holes). At the conclusion of play on Sunday, July 6, the low scorer will be the 2008 Fourth of July Champion. In the event of a tie, a sudden-death playoff beginning at hole number one will be conducted immediately.

Mid-Senior, Senior and Super-Senior Flights (ASGA designated): 54 holes stroke play to be played as follows: *Friday, July 4:* 18 holes; *Saturday, July 5:* 18 holes. *Sunday, July 6:* 18 holes. At the conclusion of play for entrants in each flight on Sunday, July 6, the low scorers will be the 2007 Fourth of July Champions for their respective flights.

Match-Play Flights (non-designated): Number of flights shall be determined by total number of entrants, not to exceed 24. Each flight shall consist of eight competitors. Flighting and seeding shall be according to qualifying scores. *Each entrant shall return a qualifying score no later than Wednesday, July 2, at 8:00 p.m.* All matches are scheduled for 18 holes. *Friday, July 4:* First round of match play (quarterfinals). Winners advance to upper brackets;

advance to consolation brackets. *Saturday, July 5:* Second round of match play (semifinals). Winners in upper and consolation brackets advance to final matches; remainder eliminated. *Sunday, July 6:* Third round of match play (finals). Champions, runners-up, consolation winners and consolation runners-up in respective flights to be determined.

Championship, Mid-Senior, Senior and *Super-Senior Flights:* Wed., July 2. *Match-Play Flights:* Wed., July 27, or when 24 entries are received, whichever is earlier.
